Dear Parents/Carers,

As a country, we all need to do what we can to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus. The government has issued clear guidance for educational establishments on maintaining educational provision. Please follow the link below.

We would like to reassure families that we are following all DfE guidance and making appropriate provision for the children of vulnerable families and key workers.

We will maintain contact with you throughout the period of partial closure and update you as and when we receive more information.

We have risk assessed all families and individual children. We are not having any children onsite from next week. All families who need them will receive weekly phone calls, more vulnerable (as identified according to criteria) will have daily calls.

Our families can be very large so having one child at school is not in the best interests of the family or child to do this so you will have individual conversations with families around what you need if you fall into this category.

Free School Meals

We are providing weekly food parcels for all families accessing free school meals including Reception to yr 2. (You will receive a text with a weekly pick up time.)

Home learning

All children have three weeks of targeted home learning and we will be delivering on a three -week basis after Easter to supplement this so that all families will be seen or talked as often as possible.

We will update you through texts and letters of changes to this.

Please stay safe and follow the guidance to keep families at home as much as possible or be in the open air.
